This Week's Attendance

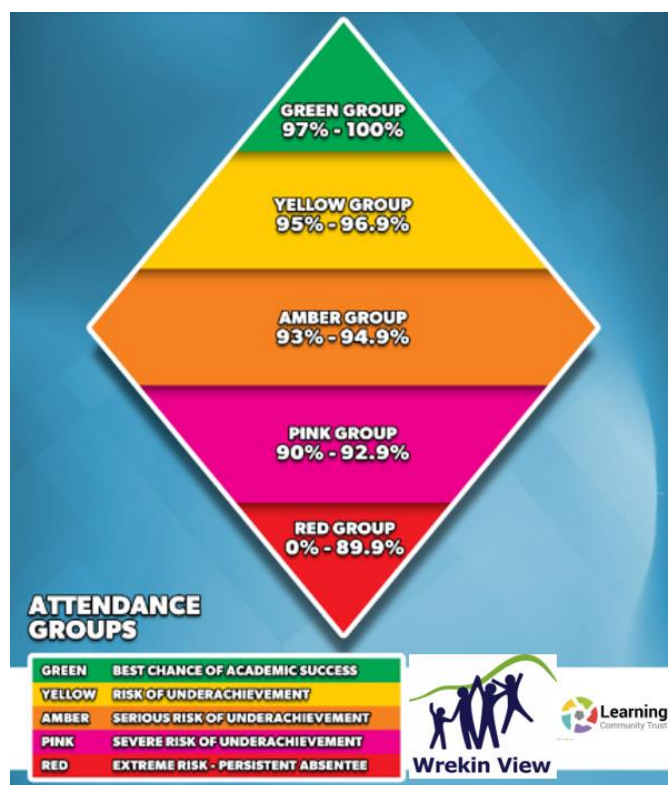
